One Minute or less

I/We will read a daily devotional guide at [time of day].

I/We will combine the Spiritual Practices checked above.
I/We will sit in silence in God's Presence for 10 minutes, practicing Centering Prayer.
I/We will begin the following spiritual practice(s):
I/We make this commitment for Lent 2016, with God's Help. If we fail one day, we promise to begin again the next day.
